Fri 10/8	Submit DRAFT project application .pdf export from E-snaps and required local CoC application documents via online form. <b><i>Once submitted no changes will be allowed to project applications or additional CoC required documents until after Rank and Review has been completed.</i></b>
Thur 10/14 to Thur 10/21	Housing First Assessment Review- by GKCCEH staff, with scoring given to Rank and Review Panel with other material

	Renewal projects sent to Rank & Review Panel Technical review of project applications by GKCCEH staff, including redacting of all agency information.
Fri 10/22	Project applications that were not selected to go in front of the Rank and Review Panel are notified by letter and phone.
Mon 10/24 thru Fri 10/29	Rank & Review Panel Process
Mon 11/1	Agencies with projects that are recommended for reallocation are notified via phone and in writing by GKCCEH Staff.
