



2022 HUD HMIS Data Standards Summary of Changes

INTRODUCTION

HUD has released the new Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 HUD HMIS Data Standards, which will take effect Friday, October 1st, 2021. Below is a summary of the changes that will be rolled out on that date.

HUD UNIVERSAL DATA ELEMENTS

Updates to Elements

3.04 Race – Revised language for response options

- 'American Indian or Alaska Native' is now 'American Indian, Alaska Native, or Indigenous'
- 'Asian' is now 'Asian or Asian American'
- 'Black or African American' is now 'Black, African American, or African'
- 'Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander' is now 'Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander'

3.05 Ethnicity – Revised language for response options

- 'Hispanic/Latino' is now 'Hispanic/Latin(a)(o)(x)'
- 'Non-Hispanic/Non-Latino' is now 'Non-Hispanic/Non-Latin(a)(o)(x)'

3.06 Gender - Revised language for response options and collection allowing multiple selections

- 'Gender Non-Conforming' is now 'A gender that is not singularly 'Female' or 'Male' (e.g., non-binary, genderfluid, agender, culturally specific gender)'
- 'Transgender' – new response option
- 'Questioning' – new response option
- 'Trans Female (MTF or Male to Female)' has been removed
- 'Trans Male (FTM or Female to Male)' has been removed

3.15 Relationship to HoH – System Logic Change and Guidance

3.20 Housing Move-in Date – System Logic Change and Guidance

COMMON PROGRAM SPECIFIC DATA ELEMENTS

- Added logic for how to treat a person aging into adulthood for Income and Sources and Non-Cash Benefits
- Added three new Referral Event response options to the Coordinated Entry Event
- Changed Mental Health Problem to Mental Health Disorder
- Changed Substance Abuse Disorder to Substance Use Disorder
- Revised Data Collection requirements for Pregnancy Status

HUD: COC PROGRAM SPECIFIC DATA ELEMENTS

- New Well-being element added
- New Moving On element added for Moving On projects

- New Youth Education Status added for YHDP projects
- New data element requirement for General Health Status

HOPWA PROGRAM SPECIFIC DATA ELEMENTS

- Revised language options for HOPWA Services Provided
- New field response for Medical Assistance
- New Prescribed Anti-Retroviral element
- Changed “Data Collected About” language for T-Cell and Viral Load

VA PROGRAM SPECIFIC DATA ELEMENTS

- Merged and added new responses for Financial Assistance Type
- Revised the HP Targeting Criteria Element
